I feel privileged and blessed enough in sharing with you all that the core of mine, every member of my, 30 Non-Teaching Staff, my 80 Teaching Staff, and my Apex, the School Management continues to see the next day Sun, the greatest of the most dearest ingredients, 2450 Students are all there growing and developing under my social, cultural, intellectual and ecological dynamo. "Zero casualties reported" in this bunch of close relatives is something at which I must slow down, take a halt, join hands, bow down and pay reverence to His "Great Care".
